

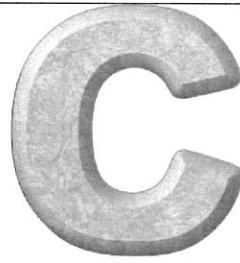
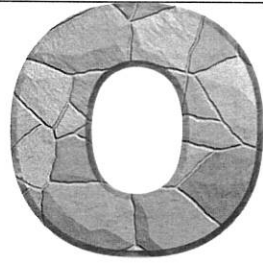
ROCK BINGO

How to play:

1. Each player has a different colour set of counters.
2. Put a rock in each square of the ROCK board.
3. The caller reads out descriptions of rocks.
4. Each player puts a counter on a rock that matches the description.
5. When a player has 4 counters in a row they call out ROCK!

Description cards (Cut them out and shuffle. Pick one up at a time to read.)

A rock with two colours.	An unusual rock.	A polished rock.	A rock with tiny holes.
A river rock.	A rock made of layers.	A rock with cracks.	A rock found near a volcano.
A rock made up of tiny rocks.	A rock that has travelled a long way.	A rock that might be magnetic.	A rock found on a mountain.
A rock with more than two colours.	A newly broken rock.	A rock with minerals in it.	A rock found at the beach.
